**Undergraduate Summer Programs**

The primary program of the enrolled student determines tuition and fee rates. This document describes tuition and fees for undergraduate students in Summer 2025. Except where otherwise noted, these rates apply to all registered credit hours in the semester. These costs do not include books and optional campus services such as housing, dining plans, parking permits, and others. Summer semester tuition and fee rates are updated annually.

Additional course fees may be required, as listed on the schedule of classes.

**Newcomb-Tulane College (NTC)**

These rates apply to NTC students with ad-hoc registration(s) not participating in a summer minor institute or abroad program.

**School of Professional Advancement (SoPA)**

These rates apply to SoPA students with ad-hoc registration(s) not participating in a summer minor institute.

Cross-listed courses from other schools*	\$642 per hour
All other courses	\$1,313 per hour
