Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)

The primary program of the enrolled student determines tuition and fee rates. This document describes tuition and fees for Nursing Program students. Except where otherwise noted, these rates apply to all registered credit hours in the semester. These costs do not include books and optional campus services such as housing, dining plans, health insurance premiums, parking permits, required computer hardware, and others. Tuition and fee rates are updated annually with each new Fall semester. Additional course fees may be required, as listed on the Schedule of Classes.

Tulane Student Health Insurance Plan (T-SHIP)

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Glossary of Mandatory Fees

The fees listed below are mandatory costs of attendance and are due from the student regardless of participation or receipt of a funded service. Fees are not refunded after the deadline listed on the University Academic Calendar for 100% tuition and fee refund.

Academic Support Services Fee (Nursing Only) – This fee supports student uploading and storage of clinical compliance data and communication related to compliance and successful course completion. It includes a comprehensive testing and review program, integrated throughout the curriculum, with learning tools that measure mastery of course content, identify strengths and areas for improvement, improve test-taking abilities, and ultimately support successfully passing the professional licensure exam (NCLEX).

Student Activity Fee - The student body at Tulane has assessed itself a Student Activity Fee to support its activities. The Student Activity fee entitles students to participate in or attend supported activities, readership of a weekly student newspaper, and admission to many events, movies, and lectures.

Campus Health Fee - The Campus Health fee provides students with primary, psychiatric, and contraceptive care at the Campus Health Center. It also contributes to health education programs, drug/alcohol counseling, and the Tulane Emergency Medical Service. This fee is not a health insurance premium.
