Summer Minor Institutes and Special Programs

The programs listed below modify the effective tuition rate for courses offered by each program.

Program	Brief Description	Tuition and Fees
Newcomb-Tulane College Maymester Augustmester	Tulane's Maymester and Augustmester are intensive two-week summer sessions. Maymester courses meet 10 am - 3pm May 11 - May 22. Newcomb-Tulane College Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL) Summer Institute	TESL Summer Institute provides in-service and pre-service teachers the content and skills needed to become qualified to teach English as a Second Language. Students who earn all credits from all four courses offered will meet the requirements for an English as a Second Language endorsement in the state of Louisiana. https://global.tulane.edu/esl/tesl	Tuition: \$700.00 per course
School of Architecture Real Estate Summer Minor Institute	An intensive 8-week program designed to help students obtain the essential knowledge and skills for entry level positions and careers in the real estate industry, both residential and commercial. School of Business Business Summer Minor Institute	This accelerated 10-week program provides undergraduates with the fundamentals of business and the skills necessary to shine in the corporate world. School of Liberal Arts U.S. Public Policy Minor Program	The Public Policy minor program will give students a foundation for graduate school in public policy or a career in government and politics at the local, state or national level. School of Liberal Arts Stacy Mandel Palagye and Keith Palagye Program for Middle East Peace	A five-week summer program giving fifteen Tulane students an immersion in the dynamics of the Arab-Israeli conflict through classroom study and hands-on experience in Jerusalem.
